






REGULAR TIMBER HARVESTING ECOSYSTEMS AND ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES PRESERVED

SUBSTAINABLE FOREST MANAGEMENT FOR A LONG TERM TIMBER PRODUCTION



Forests managed by Pallisco consist of more than 300 species of trees among which only 20 are regularly traded. The tree harvesting is carried out once every 30 years following diameters of cut that allow the reconstitution of forest stands. The rarest and most sensitive species are excluded from the harvesting in order to their preservation. By only cutting one tree per hectare and rotation, Pallisco provides an annual production of more than 100,000 m³.

REDUCED IMPACT LOGGING METHODS

Pallisco implements logging practices ensuring the integrity of the most important areas for biodiversity and for maximum security for its operators. The streams shores, swamps and steep slopes are excluded from logging and an important part of the forest massif is placed as reserve. The harvesting operations are held after large mammals inventories in order to prevent its potential impacts.



SUPPORT FOR FOREST REGENERATION

Collected trees are replaced by young plants from our nurseries.

Based on the ecology of the selected species, plantings are
carried out on large scale plots as well as in cutting gaps.

At least 5,000 wood species are planted every year.



MONITORING OF THE FOREST

The forest managed by Pallisco is regularly visited by teams supported by the forestry Administration to prevent illegal activities such as poaching, illegal logging or land clearings. All access points to the main forest are surrounded by guarded fences.

COMMITMENT TO A ECONOMIC, SOCIAL AND CULTURAL HARMONIOUS DEVELOPMENT

A PERMANENT CONSULTATION WITH INDIGENOUS PEOPLE AND FMUs LOCAL POPULATIONS

Consultations are held throughout the year to identify sacred sites and essential trees to cultural practices in order to define adequate conditions of preservation. Meetings are regularly held and implemented by Pallisco to identify development projects for the benefit of the populations. Each year, chacritable works are built for an average budget of 30 millions CFAF.



MODERN CONDITIONS OF LIFE AND WORK

Pallisco & CIFM employees and their families benefit from comfortable housing, water, free electricity and free health care. They have access to basic products (basic commodities) at cost prices to the company store. Besides, employees benefit from regular training allowing them to take on additional responsibilities in these companies.

TRAINING AND COLLABORATION WITH NATIONAL INSTITUTES

Pallisco & CIFM are incubators of talents and invest in the training of the future actors of the forest sector. Every year, several students undergo internships or training in the companies. Many of them integrate Pallisco & CIFM workforce later on.



RELATIONSHIPS WITH PARTNERS

Pallisco is accompanying different research institutes and NGOs in the preservation of its forests and the wildlife and in the integration of climate change concerns. Various local and international NGOs contribute to ensure the compatibility of forestry activities with the interests of the local populations. Collaborations are established with health professionals to improve medical services to employees and their families.
